  - acetic acid of a concentration exceeding 10 % by weight of acetic acid (heading 2915);
  - medicaments of heading 3003 or 3004; or
  - perfumery or toilet preparations (Chapter 33).
- For the purposes of this chapter and of Chapters 20 and 21, the alcoholic strength by volume shall be determined at a temperature of 20 °C.
- For the purposes of heading 2202, the term 'non-alcoholic beverages' means beverages of an alcoholic strength by volume not exceeding 0,5 % vol. Alcoholic beverages are classified in headings 2203 to 2206 or heading 2208 as appropriate.

2. Tell us how [technical barriers to trade \(TBT\) already notified](#) to the Commission may hinder your exports.
3. Launch a formal procedure under the EU's [Trade Barriers Regulation \(TBR\)](#) if you think your business is being negatively affected by a trade obstacle. The Commission then investigates and determines whether there is evidence of a violation of international trade rules.

## SPS: Sanitary and Phytosanitary Issues

Sanitary and phytosanitary (SPS) measures are often necessary to protect human, animal and plant life or health, including to protect them from risks arising from imported goods. Such measures should be based on the WTO SPS Agreement, international standards, recommendations or guidelines or be based on scientific principles. However, third countries often impose unjustified SPS measures in a way that the SPS measure negatively affects the EU exports of agriculture and fishery products.

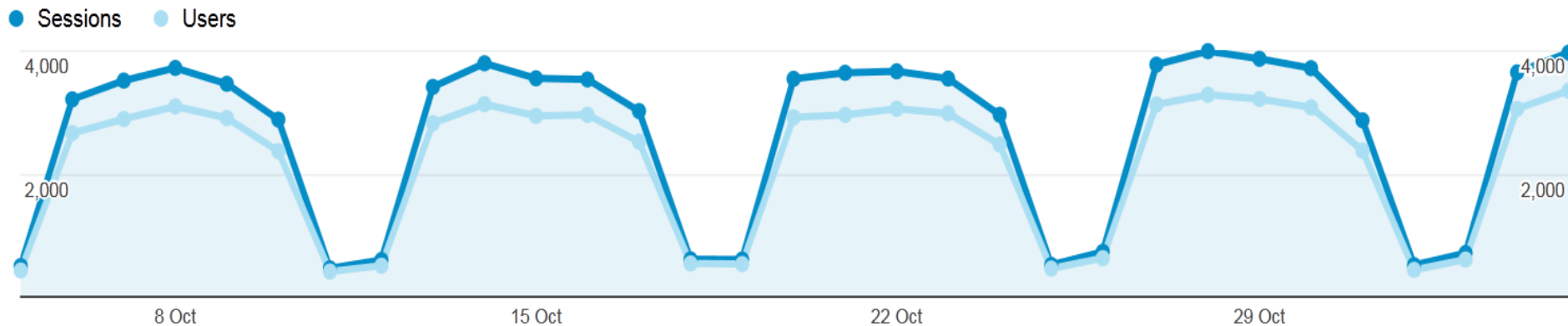

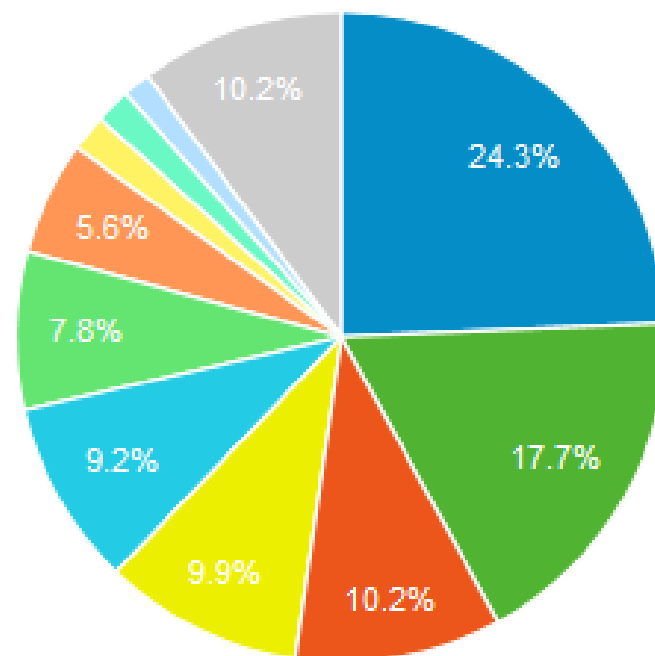
# MADB dashboard – 4 Oct. – 5 Nov. 2014
