SUBJECT: **Night Vision Surveillance Equipment (NVSE) Conference/Industry Day.**

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen,

I am pleased to announce that NSPA is organizing the 10th NVSE Conference/Industry Day from **13 to 14 February 2024 in Rovaniemi** sponsored by NSPO Night Vision and Optoelectronics (NVO) Support Partnership¹ and hosted by Finland.

The scope of this event is the **latest generation** of Night Vision and Optoelectronics, particularly sniper clip-on devices, augmented reality. This scope includes thermal sights with auxiliary sniper equipment (spotter scope, weather station, ballistic calculator, etc.)

The objective is to bring together military and NSPA specialists with **NATO and SWE original equipment manufacturers (OEM)** to exchange operational, technical and logistics information for the acquisition and in-service support of this equipment.

The schedule will include briefings from NSPA on contractual and technical topics, completed with national inputs from the participating nations. Participating companies will have the possibility to brief NSPA and the participating nations on the products and technology to be on display at a military training facility with the option of long-range observation and application on sniper equipment to be made available. Only observation & demonstration of the equipment are foreseen at the exhibition, i.e. no life firing.

Industry participation in this event will only be by invitation upon verification of the scope and audience criteria set forth. Therefore, manufactures with products within the listed categories are encouraged to express their interest by email to nvse@nspa.nato.int no later than **1 September 2023**, providing the company details, contact info and the list of equipment proposed, supported by the respective brochure or datasheet.

Invitations will be released, together with the agenda and admin remarks, shortly after said date.

Should any equipment be subject to export control, please contact NSPA on the email provided at the earliest opportunity to see after the related requirements.

I look forward to your participation in what promises to be an exceptional event.
