



Conformity Assessment of Goods to be Exported to Algeria



The Program

Following the circular n° 16/DGC/2009 from the Bank of Algeria dated 16 February 2009 and in accordance with the Algerian law 0404-2004, Executive Decree n° 05-465 and Executive Decree n° 05-467, all regulated products to be imported into Algeria must be accompanied by a Certificate of Conformity issued by an authorized Inspection and Certification Body to testify that the goods are in compliance with the technical regulations and standards applicable in Algeria. The regulated products are all goods that impact public health, safety and the environment as per Decree n° 05-465.

The required Certificate of Conformity has also been referred to as the "Certificat de Contrôle de Qualité de la Marchandise" in the Bank of Algeria circular. It is mandatory for customs clearance.

The Objectives

The key objective of the program is to make sure that the all imported consignments of regulated products meet the mandatory quality, safety, and security requirements as per the Algerian technical regulations and standards approved by IANOR (Institut Algérien de Normalisation).

To facilitate trade and avoid delays in customs clearance and potential losses by importers in case the goods are found noncompliant with the mandatory requirements, it is recommended that the conformity assessment and verification activities be conducted by a competent Certification and Inspection Body in the country of export.
