MAILUU-SUUI LAMP FACTORY

The company, founded more than half a century ago, has passed all the stages of its development and today JSC Mailuu-Suui Lamp Plant (hereinafter referred to as JSC MSLZ) is the leading largest plant for the production of electric lamps in the former Soviet Union.

The company specializes in the production of general-purpose incandescent electric lamps, local lighting, decorative, portable sewing, automotive lamps and energy-saving LED lamps. In addition to electric lamps, the plant generates thermal energy for its own technological needs, special technological equipment, provides industrial services to the public and third-party organizations, produces glass-making, fiber-optic fiber, toilet paper.

Construction of the plant was started in December 1964, after the publication of the Decree of the Government of the USSR "On the construction of the 50th anniversary of the Komsomol Electric lamp plant in Maili-Sai", signed by the Chairman of the Presidium of the USSR Anastas Ivanovich Mikoyan, and already in 1966 the main building of the enterprise was put into operation. The company reached the design capacity of 302 million electric lamps per year in 1974.

The plant has a solid repair base, which makes it possible to manufacture special technological equipment, spare parts and tools for major repairs of equipment in workshops, power production, and is equipped with its own motor transport facilities.

For 60 years of its existence, the plant has been a leader in the production of incandescent and automotive lamps. Currently, the production capacity of JSC "MSLZ" is 50.0-70.0 million units of electric lamps per year. All manufactured electric lamps are sold: in the domestic market about 20-30% and for export 70-80% of the total shipment.

During the entire period of operation of the plant from 1964 to the present, the organizational form of management has changed several times: a state-owned enterprise, a joint-stock company, a limited liability company, and in fact the plant is located at its original address, specializing in the production of incandescent lamps at the same production facilities. Thus, in connection with the reorganization of the plant under the PESAC program in 1995, a new enterprise was organized on the basis of the Mailuu Electric Lamp Plant named after the 50th anniversary of the Komsomol-the state joint-stock Company Mailuu - Suu Electric Lamp Plant (MS ELZ).

In 1998 GAO "MS ELZ" was transformed into an open joint-stock company "Mailuu-Suu Electric Lamp Plant "(AOOT "MS ELZ") with a change in the type of ownership.

On September 4, 2003, Open Joint-Stock Company Mailuu-Suu Electric Lamp Plant (OJSC MS ELZ) was registered on the basis of AOOT "MS ELZ".

On February 16, 2009, after the application of the Bankruptcy Department under the State Property Management Committee of the Kyrgyz Republic to declare OJSC MS ELZ bankrupt (insolvent), the Interdistrict Court of Jalal-Abad issued a decision to declare the plant bankrupt (insolvent) and a special administration procedure was assigned to the plant. On January 1, 2011, a new legal entity, the Mailuu-Suu Lamp Factory Limited Liability Company, was created on the basis of the assets of Open Joint Stock Company Mailuu-Suu Electric Lamp Factory.

On June 28, 2022, the company was reorganized from the Mailuu-Suu Lamp Factory Limited Liability Company by converting it into the Mailuu-Suu Lamp Factory Open Joint Stock Company (MSLZ OJSC), a 100% share of the Financial and Credit Fund under the Ministry of Finance of the Kyrgyz Republic.

By the Resolution of the Cabinet of Ministers of the Kyrgyz Republic No. 354 of 12.07.2023, the functions of exercising the powers to act as a shareholder of JSC "MSLZ" were transferred from the Financial and Credit Fund under the Ministry of Finance of the Kyrgyz Republic to the State Agency for State Property Management under the Cabinet of Ministers of the Kyrgyz Republic.

MSLZ products are certified and meet the requirements of the international standard ISO 9001: 2015. There is an international quality certificate issued by DEKRA, confirming compliance of the quality management system with the international standard ISO 9001 series.

All manufactured products are certified by the standard services of Russia and Kyrgyzstan, and electric lamps that are at the stage of development and undergoing testing are subject to certification. The plant's products were repeatedly awarded with diplomas and medals of regional and specialized exhibitions.

Currently, the amount of financial turnover per year is about 11.0 million US dollars. The number of employees employed at the plant is more than 1300 people.

The production of electric lamps begins with the production of our own semi-finished products and ends with the assembly of electric lamps on assembly lines, control and shipment of finished products to consumers.

MSLZ products are exported to such countries as: Russia, Kazakhstan, Turkmenistan, Azerbaijan, Georgia.

The main production of the plant is concentrated in Mailuu-Suu. The total area of the company's territory is 41.92 hectares, including the area of the main production facility in Mailuu-Suu is 26.3 hectares. The main and auxiliary workshops of JSC "MSLZ" are: The assembly shop directly produces electric lamps. The plinth and cartoning shop is engaged in the production of aluminum plinths and cardboard containers for the production of electric lamps. The electrode-spiral shop is engaged in the production of current inputs (electrode), a glow body (spiral) and molybdenum holders for the production of electric lamps. The glass shop is engaged in the production of glass and plastic products (glass flask, dart glass, plate, stengel, shtabik) for the production of electric lamps. The technological aging shop is engaged in checking electric lamps for quality. The Gas and Energy Service is engaged in the development of various energy resources for the production of electric lamps. The tool and machine shop is engaged in the production of spare parts and tools for equipment. The boiler house is engaged in the generation of thermal energy for technological and shop needs. There are also workshops for electrical equipment, a motor transport shop, a repair and construction site, and a service for industrial electronics and communications. One of the company's workshops is a transshipment base located in Shamalduu - Sai. This shop is engaged in receiving all incoming cargo to the plant and sending finished products to consumers by rail.

Due to the global development of LED lamps, the demand for incandescent lamps is decreasing, for this reason, the company is working on the conversion of production.

In December 2024, the company started manufacturing energy-saving LED SMD lamps.

On the occasion of the Independence Day of the Kyrgyz Republic, August 29, 2025, with the participation of the President of the Kyrgyz Republic, a grand opening of a new production of glass containers with a design capacity of up to 70 million units of production per year was held in an online format. The implementation of this project was an important step in the development of the domestic industry and allowed creating more than 200 new jobs.

The company also plans to develop the following production facilities:

- **Construction of a small hydroelectric power station with a capacity of 26.4 MW on the Mailuu-Suu River;**
- **Development of the production of mineral insulation wool – 2026-2027.**

Taking into account the status of the plant as a city-forming enterprise, improving its financial and economic condition will lead to an increase in the welfare of the plant's employees, the socio-economic situation of the city and its residents, improve the city's infrastructure, and provide the population with additional jobs.
