




## The Digital4Development (D4D Hub) Launch

- Successful <u>high-level launch</u> on December 8<sup>th</sup>, 2020, with participation of EU COM President von der Leyen and EU MS Heads of States, private sector and civil society
- Launch of the Africa and Latin America and Caribbean branches
- Announcement of pre-launch in Asia in February 2022
- 12\* EU Member States joined the D4D Hub through a Joint Letter of Intent








#### THE D4D HUB IN BRIEF



The <u>D4D Hub</u> serves as a **strategic multi-stakeholder platform** that fosters digital cooperation between the D4D Team Europe and its global partners.



- The D4D Team Europe is composed of digital visionaries from multiple stakeholder groups coming together for a joint action
- It creates opportunities for dialogue, partnerships and investments to advance the human centric model of digital transformation in partner countries
- o It builds a joint digital expertise and networks
- It aims at pooling resources, fostering visibility and impact for Team Europe Interventions
- It promotes the exchange of information, good practices and lessons learnt on Digital4Development








- In October 2021 and in January 2022, two preparatory meetings were organised with private sector companies
- Draft ToRs and application process were designed by the D4D Hub Secretariat & DG INTPA and shared with MS and private sector companies for feedback in Q4 2021 and Q1 2022
- Application process to join the Private Sector AG was launched end of April 2022. Acceptance Letter sent to first EU applicants in September 2022.
- Launch of the second phase in November 2022 with companies in partner countries (applications until December 15th)
- In January & July 2022, two preparatory meetings were organised with CSOs organisations
- Draft ToRs were designed with support of IDEA's project and shared with MS and CSOs for feedback in Q3 2022
- Aiming at launching the official application process in Q4 2022 opening to both CSOs and Academia the opportunity to apply



- Provide technical support on new regional D4D TEIs




#### EU-LAC Latin America and the Caribbean: Global Gateway – the Digital Alliance Flagships
