16h-17h30: Closing Session

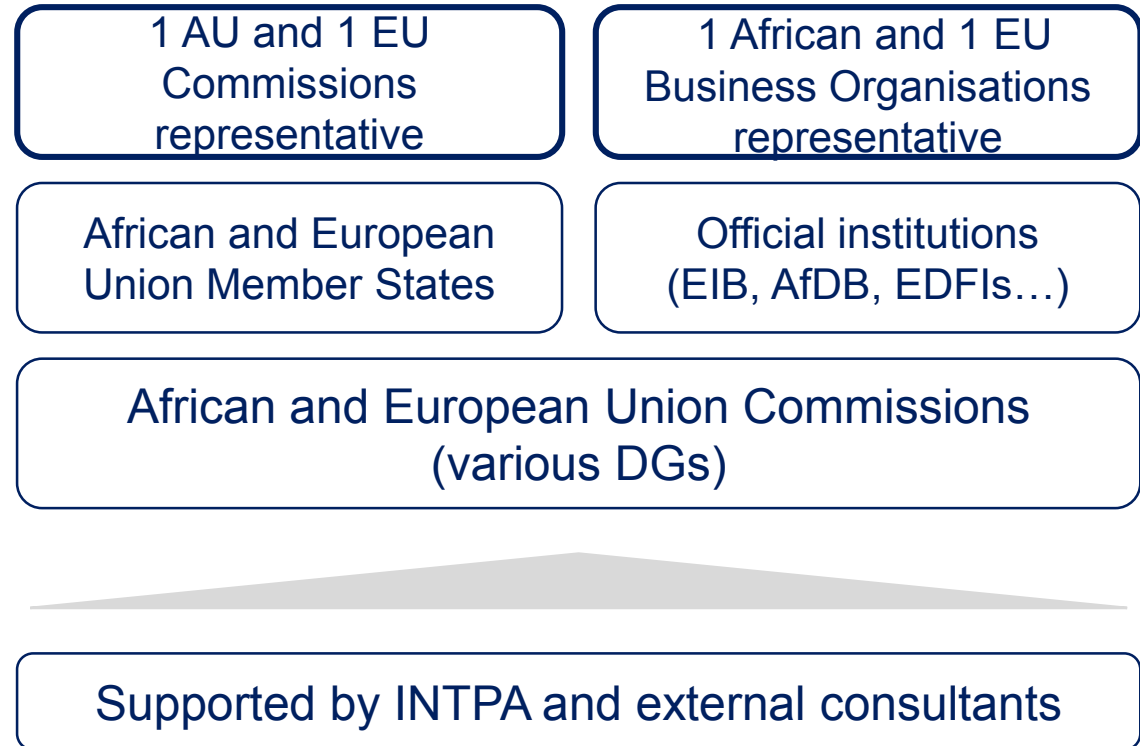

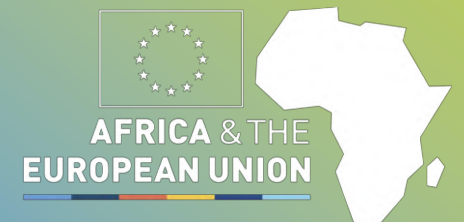


