We facilitatetraveling by seamless e-combination of GEO information, real-time scheduling, planning and booking across all modes of transport and across borders

As an independent mobility service provider we ease daily mobility by integrating all mobility service providers (including flight, train, own car, car sharing, taxi, other private and public passenger transport providers...) in one single hub.

All options of how to get doo-to-door from A to B (address precise) are made transparent and filtered according to price, time, comfort and CO2 emissions. The traveler gets the travel recommendation that fits the most to his individual profile.

The traveler can book all means of transport through our web based booking engine via direct interfaces we have with all transport providers.

Using location based services we guide travelers along their trip. Through services like navigation, real-time travel information and location-based push services, we introduce new dimensions to travelling.

In a greater perspective, the target is optimal coordination of all available mobility carriers in the eRegion for domestic and cross-border travelling and we stand for ecologic sustainability in an economic mobility network.
