Cross-border eSolution/eService Prototype Development

Prototype title:

Slovenian E-Invoice System

Short description of the prototype (problem to be solved, expected benefits, main stakeholders, expansion opportunities, related EU projects, references):

E-Invoice System in Slovenia includes banks (currently 16 banks) and central processor (Bankart). The system facilitates the exchange of e-documents (e-invoice, e-return information, e-login/e-logout for receiving e-invoices, e-delivery information) on the way from sender to receiver. Exchange is currently available only in the area of Slovenia. The aim of further development is the exchange carried out in the framework of the EU.

The replacement of the paper-based exchange of e-invoices and other e-documents through E-Invoice System offers to all the participants following benefits: reduction of costs, simplification of processes, easier and faster operations and control.

An idea on setting up a system for e-invoice exchange was formed in Slovenia in 2007. The initiative came from some banks under the auspices of the Bank Association of Slovenia (BAS). The Public Payments Administration (UJP – includes companies which are financed from the state budget) will connect to the system in September 2012.

As the EU fully supports (in its objectives) the introduction of e-invoice the time to test the exchange across borders of Slovenia is more than adequate.

Open questions:

1. Legislation
2. Exchange standard
3. Standardization of basic system operation

ICT requirements for the prototype deployment:

Adaptation of e-banking solution for work with e-invoices with all participants in the system (banks, processors, issuers and recipients), IT upgrade of programs for the creation of e-invoices (ERP system).
