The environmental dimension of the sustainable development framework has been identified to be one of the greatest challenges ahead of human civilization for next decades. We are all aware that the available resources of our planet are not unlimited and transformation towards green economy is a must. Due to the growing global population accompanied by measures towards eradicating poverty and making our lives better it is of key importance to ensure that the natural resources are managed in a sustainable way. However, this challenge cannot be properly addressed if the importance of swift development and implementation of green, environment friendly technologies are not widely recognized. Therefore, environment protection must be closely linked with respective green technologies. Ensuring the close cooperation on development and implementation of green technologies between countries and companies should be considered as a top priority.

During the Central&Eastern Europe and China Summit (so called 16+1 Initiative) held on 26 November 2013 in Bucharest, Prime Minister of the Republic of Poland declared to organize a special event in the 2014, which would facilitate exchange of experience and enhance cooperation between CEE and China in the field of green technologies. Following this announcement, I cordially invite the policy makers and green business representatives of CEE countries and China to participate in a full day special event entitled "Building Green Bridges between CEE and China". This event is to be held on October 16, 2014, during the largest environmental trade fairs POLEKO in Poznań, Poland. It is intended to provide the participants with a dialogue platform on exploring enhanced cooperation on green technologies between central/regional governments and business/companies levels in CEE and China. The morning session will focus on exchanging the already undertaken measures and experience gained (incl. Polish Green Technology Accelerator – Greenevo), while the afternoon session will provide good opportunity for business-to-business meetings, in particular for SMEs in green technologies sector. We will conclude with business mixer dinner. Due to available meeting capacity, the number of participants will be limited to 200.

The Ministry of the Environment of the Republic of Poland as an organizer will be handling out all the logistics and organization issues. All participants are requested to arrange their travel and accomodation for the event on their own. The World Trade Center in Poznań will provide the necessary assistance in terms of hotel bookings (contact details are provided in the attached registration form). The organizer will provide meals (lunch and dinner), as well as free entry passes to 2014 POLEKO Environmental Trade Fairs ("Green Design" will be the key theme this year), including guided tour on 16 October. The final agenda and further logistics information will be provided in due time to registered participants.
