

## ONE BELT, ONE ROAD --A NEW ECONOMIC PARADIGM EMERGES

"One Belt, One Road" is a development strategy initiated by China government in 2013. It refers to the New Silk Road Economic Belt, which links China with Europe through Central and Western Asia, and the 21st Century Maritime Silk Road, connecting China with Southeast Asian countries, Africa and Europe.

The scope of the "Belt and Road" initiative has continued to expand and now includes promotion of enhanced policy coordination across the Asian continent, financial integration, trade liberalization, and people-to-people connectivity.

The workshop aims to gather the participants from various business incubators and high-tech innovation service agencies in relevant countries along the "Belt and Road". It focuses on developing the cooperation of science, technology and economy, as well as promoting the mutual communication and integration of different cultures. In addition, the workshop helps to propose an international development strategy for domestic and foreign enterprises through the experience exchange.

Set up in 1989, Torch High Technology Industry Development Center (Torch Center) is an integral part of the Ministry of Science & Technology (MOST), China. With the general purpose of reinforcing the overall

Shanghai International Business Incubator (IBI) was established in 1997 with approval from Ministry of Science & Technology. It takes the organization model of "One Incubator, Several Bases". Now IBI has 9 incubation

bases, including Shanghai Technology Innovation Center (STIC), Juke Biotech Park, Yangpu Technology Innovation Center, Withub Technology Innovation Center and Shanghai University Science Park, which represent the top 9 incubators in Shanghai. IBI aims to assist the domestic SMEs develop an internationalization strategy and seize the opportunities of global markets, as well as carrying out innovative and commercial cooperation for domestic and foreign enterprises.

Shanghai IBI works as the secretariat for Asia Enterprise Incubation Association. IBI is a member of the World Bank infoDev, a multi-donor program that supports entrepreneurs in developing economies.

### SHANGHAI JUKE BIOTECH PARK

Shanghai Juke Biotech Park is a professional biotech industry cluster co-founded by Shanghai Xuhui Municipal Government and Shanghai Institutes for Biological Sciences affliation of China Academy of Sciences in 2003. JUKE bears the commitment of biotech industry incubation by innovation talents training and technology transfer. Taking the advantage of technology, market and capital integration, JUKE endeavors to become a leading biotech industry cluster for R&D and innovative technology transfer in Shanghai. Within the past 13 years development, JUKE has set up three incubator divisions and one manufacture base in Shanghai, which has 120,000 m² industry space in total. So far, over 300 innovative biotech companies have settled down right here.

The member companies of JUKE are being served with a dual service model created by Juke Park, a Relay-cultivation Model served with start-up nursery, incubator, accelerator and Industry Park, and the other Company Incubation Model served with tutor, professional incubator and venture capital, respectively. JUKE dedicates to promoting the development of innovative biotech industry cluster in Shanghai and collaborates with other biotech parks in Yangtze River delta region.
